Dear parents,

First, I want to thank you for coming to parent/teacher conferences last Friday. I am very thankful for each of you, and I truly mean that. After speaking with all of you, and hearing what you all were saying. I feel like we need to clear somethings up. I am sorry if they were not clear, and if your child came home and said something different. We are struggling with telling the truth in class, being kind to one another, and obeying the teacher(s). I have spoken with the girls about all of the issues, and explained the consequences going forward. A few things that I would like to make sure we are clear on are the following.

Homework- We have struggled with being on schedule every week this school year. Which has caused our class to be behind in a few subjects. Going forward if this happens then you might see more than normal homework from your child. I am also having students "hide" work in their desk or it magically disappears and does not come back. Please make sure you are checking their grades on Renweb. If you don't know how to do this I can help you with this.

Math Facts- Each student is required to complete their math facts, and get the paper signed that is in their binder. The ONLY day the math facts are not to be completed is Wednesday night. This allows you to spend more time together as a family and go to church. This is a daily grade that goes towards their math test.

Planner- Each student is required to fill it out in class, and take it home to be signed. This is a daily grade.

Spelling/Bible- Each student is required to write their words/memory verse 5 times. Two times in cursive and three times in print. This is a grade.

Bonus papers- This paper is suppose to be completed as soon as the student finishes their test on the test day. I have started it as a bonus paper. This allows the students some wiggle room if it is finished. They can get Thank you for meeting with me for our parent teacher a total of 10 points for completing it towards their test. The parent and the student is required to sign it REGARDLESS if it is completed or not. This tells me that YOU and your child talked about this paper, and agreed that it was or was not benefictial to complete or not. If it is not signed then I am going to start taking 10 points off.

Reading log- Each student is required to read atleast 250 pages per month. The calendar is due back & signed at the beginning of the next month.

Grocery/shopping stores- Both of these are a reward. Our shopping store is closed until further notice. The girls will have to earn this back. If the behaviors continue then we will add more consequence to our plate.

Thank you for all you do! I want the best for these girls just like you do. We are learning a hard consequense for all of our actions. I am learning that I need to be a bit firmer and not a push over. I love you guys! Have the best Fall Break!
